


Each map we draw is unique, that's why we offer a range of styles to find the perfect fit for you.


We offer maps drawn in both traditional and digital styles.

Traditional is where a map is created with pencil, then brought to life by pen. The cartographer will use a range of tools including: A wide variety of pen nibs; Different shades of ink; Rulers; Compasses; Erasers; Tweezers; Brushes; and Bone Scrapers, to name but a few.

Traditional mediums also use calligraphy to add place names to your map to help bring it to life, and utilize traditional colouring methods such as tea staining, and watercolour.

Digital is a map that is drawn on a computer or tablet. Artists will use devices such as iPads or tablets made exclusively for artists and will utilize programs such as Photoshop and Procreate to design their pieces.



- **Does the map come with a commercial licence?**

- Yes. All of our maps come with a commercial licence which means you can use your map inside a book, as part of a game, or sell on merchandise. If you would like to discuss owning the full exclusive copyright, please mention this in your enquiry. Copyright transfer is charged at an additional cost.

- **What do you need from me to order a commission?**

We just want a rough pen sketch on paper, or a basic digital map using free software like Inkarnate. We will also need a fully proofread list of place names. - **How can I pay?**

- **Can I have my map posted to me?**
